<u>Asheville Art Safari.</u> Asheville and the surrounding region has one of the largest concentrations of fine artists and crafters in the country. Our professional guide will accompany your group on a private studio tour of at least three of Asheville's most noted artists. Popular artists with our aficionados in

Each of the Downtown Asheville microbreweries on this tour has a distinct style in their brewing and in their incredibly varied atmosphere. You will get behind-the-scenes access to several Downtown microbreweries, including meeting some of the brew-masters and understanding their craft and brewing process that leads to their final product on tap. Your guide is a friendly beer connoisseur and brewing enthusiast who is interested in expanding your taste and palette of unique ale, not just reaping beer's

great intoxicating benefits! This tour includes roundtrip transportation with professional guide from the Omni Grove Park Inn, an ample sampling of beers, and an all-inclusive beer-tasting lunch.

Whitewater River Rafting is perhaps the most popular outdoor activity for those visiting the North Carolina mountains. No other sport combines teamwork, fun and outdoor adventure like a trip down the river. If you are looking for a scenic and exhilarating adventure, this is the tour for you! 

Chimney Rock Park & Lake Lure. Chimney Rock Park is the natural fulfillment of your trip to the mountains. Take a deep breath of cool, clean mountain air, then head for the top where you can reach the Chimney and the Trails. You can take the elevator up 26 stories inside the mountain to the Sky Lounge gift shop and snack bar, or hike along an exciting trail to the top of the 500 million year old rock on the edge of a tall mountain. Alternately, if you prefer, you may take a leisurely stroll that leads through several different habitat types



including stretches of rhododendron and laurel, oak-hickory forest, and meander – by way of a boardwalk – through a small wetland area where most of the *Last of the Mohicans* movie was filmed. The trail loops from and returns to the top of the Park Meadows. Before returning to the resort, guests will tour



Lake Lure aboard a pontoon boat and enjoy the lake vistas seen in the film "Dirty Dancing." This tour includes round-trip transportation with guide from the Grove Park Inn, admission to Chimney Rock Park, the Lake Lure boat tour, bottled waters light trail snacks, and a box lunch with beverages.

Guided Waterfall Hike & Wildflower Hunt. The 10,000 acre DuPont State Forest is home to over 90 miles of trails leading hikers to beautiful waterfalls, tranquil mountain lakes, and rushing streams. In addition to its geologic features, the DuPont Forest is also home to hundreds of native plants and wildflowers in their natural habitat. Early summer is arguably the best time of year to see the most species of wildflowers at one time. Though you will be tempted to pick these beauties, this is a "photographic" hunt and the goal is to hunt and photograph the most species of wildflowers. Our professional guide will give each guest a full-



color identification chart of species that will be in bloom. The guide will help you find the species on the chart and will have field guides to help you identify other native species. A special bonus is that you will be taken to three significant and photogenic waterfalls. Two of these waterfalls were filmed in the cinematographic masterpiece *Last of the Mohicans*, and the recent *Hunger Games* blockbuster was also filmed here. This tour includes



roundtrip transportation with professional guide(s) from the Omni Grove Park Inn, a gourmet box lunch with beverages, bottled waters and light trail snacks. Please be prepared to wear comfortable clothes and shoes appropriate for a moderate walk no more than 2 miles (mostly downhill), and make sure to bring your camera because this location is a photographer's dream!

Scenic Horseback Riding. Experience fresh mountain air, breath-taking scenery and an old fashioned down-home friendliness when you go horseback riding in North Carolina's Blue Ridge Mountains. Your group will be taken to a secluded ranch just minutes north of Asheville, a ranch with picturesque trails that pass through high country, scenic mountain meadow and wooded areas. This safe and relaxing ride is for people of all ages and horseback riding abilities, and there are no weight limits. All rides are accompanied by friendly, experienced trail guides. Be sure to bring your camera as the scenery is spectacular! We recommend wearing comfortable secure footing (cowboy or hiking boots, and tennis shoes are acceptable), and long pants, such as blue jeans. In addition to a gourmet



box lunch, this excursion includes roundtrip transportation from the Omni Grove Park Inn, bottled water and light trail snacks.
